

NICOLE GALLOWAY CALENDAR ANALYSIS

Key Findings

Galloway does less work in a month than most Missourians do in a week

- Over the past 4 months, Galloway did not work 40 hours in a single month
- In four months, Galloway had scheduled work time of just 131 hours and 40 minutes; an average American works the equivalent of that in just over 3 weeks
- The average American works 9,600 minutes a month, Galloway worked 7,900 minutes over 4 months

Nicole Galloway has spent more time at fundraisers than reviewing audits

- In the same timeframe that Galloway's campaign bragged about holding over 100 fundraisers, Galloway only conducted 84 audit review sessions, including appointments labeled "audit/comms review"
